About the Ministry...

Centro Cristiano de Alabnza is located in Alajuelita, Costa Rica.

Alajuelita is one of the poorest districts in the province of San Jose. This severe poverty is devastating ; within an area of 21 square kilometers there are more than 90,000 people, a very dense population.

For this reason the CCA in its mission of evangelism in the community has consistently over the last 10 years provided meals for over 250 children a day.

In the past 10 years they have built:

A church, a school, rehabilitation centers for men and women, a medical clinic, a feeding center, a bakery, a tailor shop and two soccer fields. They have a swimming pool and restaurant in the planning and all of these enterprises bring in money to help the ministry be self-sufficient.

This ministry led by Pastor Alberto and his wife Rocio Castro along with their two sons have brought the word and works of the Lord into thousands of peoples everyday lives.
